PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO PG CLASSES 2019-20**

1. Government College (Autonomous), Bhawanipatna established in 1960, is one of the premier centres of Higher Education of advanced learning in the state. It has been functioning as an Autonomous college since 2002 and has been identified as “College with Potential for Excellence (CPE)”. The primary objectives are as follows:
 - a. To promote self-learning and creativity.
 - b. To introduce skill into the knowledge content with a view to be self-reliant.
 - c. To pursue higher studies and research so as to build a knowledge society.
 - d. To develop a sense e-spirit-de-corps through co-curricular, extra-curricular and outreach activities.

2. PG Programmes

The college provides post graduation study in the following subjects. The college has introduced semester system for examination at PG level from 2007-08 as per the letter No. 1300-D VII, Dt.05-02-2007 of the Registrar, Sambalpur University.

- i. Economics(32)
- ii. English(16)
- iii. History(16)
- iv. Oriya(16)
- v. Political Science(16)
- vi. Geography(16)

The number in brackets indicate the seats available.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- Graduate or equivalent.

4. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

Before applying for admission, applicants are advised to read the Prospectus carefully.

- Prospectus and Application Form are available in our college website www.gacbhawanipatna.org . The application fee for PG Admission is Rs.700/- which is to be paid online only.
- Applicants are to apply for PG admission by filling the Application Form online. *No other modes are accepted.*
- **Applicants are NOT required to send hard copy of the Application Form to the college.**
- On successful submission of online application form, Admit Cards will be issued to the applicant **immediately**.

- **Issue of Admit Card or appearing the Entrance Test does not ensure the eligibility of any applicant for admission.** If an applicant is selected for admission, then he/she will be required to submit appropriate documents in support of his/her claims. If the applicant fails to submit appropriate document at the time of admission then his/her claim for admission will be forfeited.
- a. On successful submission of online application form, candidates will receive an email, acknowledging its receipt by the college.

5. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- As per government norms.
- The reservation of seats in each subject is made out of the sanctioned strength in that subject. Reservation is applicable to the natives of Odisha only and is subject to change as and when the Government of Odisha does so.

6. SELECTION

- Merit list for admission will be prepared subject-wise and category wise by taking results of both Entrance Test (40% weightage) and Career mark (60% weightage). Career marks will only include Hons/Core Marks at Graduation level for Category-1 candidates and for Category-2 and Category-3, their aggregate marks of graduation will be taken into consideration. Preference for admission will be given as per the following priorities.
- i) Category-1: Hons/Core in concerned subject in +3 [1st Preference]
- ii) Category-2: Pass/Elective in concerned subject in +3 [2nd Preference]
- iii) Category-3: All others* [3rd Preference]

**However, if any candidate has studied the concerned subject at graduation level as Compulsory with Maximum mark of at least 200 or equivalent then he/she will be considered in Category-2.*

A category of candidate with lower preference will be considered only after all applications of higher preference category(s) are exhausted.

- **Equality of Marks**

In case of two candidates secure equal marks in the qualifying subjects their relative merit shall be determined on the basis of their aggregate marks in degree examination. If the aggregate mark becomes tie, in that case, the candidate who born earlier will come first in the Merit List.

7. ENTRANCE TEST

- Appearing at the Entrance Examination is **compulsory** for all candidates.
- The entrance test will be of one hour duration consisting of 50 multiple choice questions, each carrying one mark. No negative marking will be there.
- **The Entrance Test for admission into PG courses will be held on 01-07-2019 at 11AM in the college.**

Documents Required for appearing the Entrance Test:

- Admit Card with recent photograph.
- Self-attested Xerox copy of graduation marksheet.

- **Candidates are required to submit their Admit Cards and Xerox copy of the graduation marksheet at the time of submitting their Answer Scripts on the day of Entrance Test.**
- All applicants are to appear the entrance test at their own expenses.

8. INTIMATION TO THE CANDIDATES:

- i. Selected candidates will be intimated for admission through College website and College Notice Board. Candidates are advised to visit the college website regularly for updates.
- ii. Selected candidates are to report for admission at the PG Admission Section of the college in person along with requisite original documents and fees on the date and time which will be notified in the college Website and Notice Board.

9. CHANGE IN RULES
