ADMISSION

- Admission of students in Govt. Vocational Jr. College is done through traditional pattern.

- Admission to PG and M.Phil classes have been done through postal system.
- Attractive Identity Cards with Lanyards have been issued to students admitted for the session 2014-15.
- Library cards have already been distributed to all the freshers.
- 20% extension seats as per Govt. guideline have been filled in different classes and streams.
- All seats in +3 Classes have been converted into Hons. seat which was a compulsion owing to 20% extension seat.
- Physically handicapped students have been exempted from paying Certificate and Examination Fees as per the Directives of Govt.
- Extension of Seats in Horticulture Stream and opening of Poultry stream in Vocational Junior College from this session.

ACCOUNTS & FINANCE

- College introduced computerized fees collection system from this academic session.
- The software programme of "*Fees Collection System*" was developed indigenously by Sri Bishnu Prasad Choudhury with necessary guidance from Principal-Sri L.N.Sahu, Accounts Bursar-Sri Dinesh Ch.Dash, and personnel from establishment section of the college.
- Examination fees for +3 and PG students have been collected at once at the time of admission.
- One time Hostel admission and re-admission fees have been made compulsory for boarders.
- Currency Counting and fake currency detector machine has been installed in the cash counter.
- Budget for Autonomous College, Bhawanipatna has been prepared and duly approved.
- Accounts Bursar attended training on Odisha Computer Accounts Management Portal under Odisha Modernising Public Governance Administration Drive in the Finance Dept. of Govt. of Odisha.
- The Accounts Section has taken approval from the Finance Committee and Executive Committee to take up steps to develop a software programme for "*e-Expenditure system*" and the same is in its incumbency state.
